Dear LHS Senior Parents/Guardians,

We are so excited for the Lockhart High School Class of 2022 and I wanted to share some information with you regarding the activities and ceremonies that will be taking place in the near future.

Prom

Prom will take place at the Embassy Suites Hotel and Conference Center in San Marcos on May 7th, from 8:00pm - 11:30pm. Students will need to be in good standing with their attendance (minimum 90%) and discipline to attend. Seniors will get in free and Juniors will need to purchase a ticket.

Seniors and Attendance

We are working with students that owe attendance make up hours. Students have been directed to get with their assigned Assistant Principal about their hours owed. You can also find information about how to make up hours on our <u>campus website</u>. The best way for students to make up hours owed is to be at school but there are many other options listed on our website as well.

Grades and Credits

This is the time for students to be looking at their grades/credits and reaching out to administration and/or counseling staff for any assistance needed. This is the final push and we want to see every single one of our Seniors to cross that stage on May 27th!

Senior Final Exam Schedule

Senior Walk

Our Class of 2022 Senior Walk will take place on Monday, May 23rd. Seniors will load onto the buses, in the GOPAC parking lot, at 9:00am sharp.

Graduation Practice

A **MANDATORY** graduation practice will be held on May 24th, beginning at 9:30am in the LHS Gerry Ohlendorf Performing Arts Center (GOPAC). Students will meet in the GOPAC to discuss graduation day and then will be walked through the process.

Graduation Ceremony

The Class of 2022 graduation ceremony will be held at Lions Stadium on Friday, May 27th, at 8:00pm. There are no tickets for the ceremony and seating is open. The ceremony will also be live streamed and recorded for those that cannot attend. The gates will open for guests at 7:30 pm.

- Colleges that they have been accepted to (not just applied, but accepted)
- Any scholarship they are receiving
- Branch of military (if enlisted)

After copying the emailed template, creating a slide, and naming it with their full name, the Seniors are to email it to maria.narvaez@lockhart.txed.net with "Senior PPT" in the subject line. The deadline to submit a slide is May 6th.
